Music Teacher

RESPONSIBLE FOR:

The delivery of the Music Curriculum to students, Year 7-13, along with responsibility for co-curricular activities including the choir, several bands, and managing a team of itinerant music teachers.

TEACHING RESPONSIBILITIES:

- be able to work positively and co-operatively within the Department and Marsden Whitby staff team
