Professional Early Childhood Educators

Marsden Preschool staff are all professional Early Childhood educators of the highest standard, providing a varied programme to challenge and excite children, inspiring a love of learning and developing independent, selfmotivated learners.

A planned curriculum

Through a planned curriculum, based on the exploration of children's interests we extend and support learning that is purposeful and that children enjoy.

Under the guiding principles of Te Whāriki, the New Zealand Early Childhood Curriculum, children's strengths and interests are woven together to create each child's early learning experience.

Each term we conduct an inquiry focus, which extends on the children's group interest. Inquiry supports children to Engage and Wonder, Explore, Discover, Explain, Share and Reflect. This investigation is conducted through focused activities and independent exploration.

Literacy and Maths

We create fun and informative ways to embed a variety of literacy and mathematical concepts for our children throughout the day.

Digital Technology

We provide meaningful exploration with digital technology and offline activities that encourage children to develop an understanding of early digital literacy and digital fluency. Children will focus on digital technology for communication, creativity, collaboration and critical thinking.

Specialist teachers

Specialists teach te reo Māori and music in fun and creative ways. The Marsden librarian runs a weekly programme and the nurse supports us in looking after your child's health. We join Chapel service and other Marsden sporting, cultural and community events.

Facilities

Marsden Preschool is a spacious, light and sunny environment, with indoor areas for art, music, reading, dramatic play, outdoor areas for climbing, bike riding, ball games, playing with sand and water, as





well as access to all of the sports and cultural facilities of Marsden's extensive and beautiful Karori campus.

Embracing all children, Marsden's education is underpinned by Christian values. We encourage and expect respect and tolerance: seeing the best in others and getting along.

Involved families

Whānau stay connected with their children's learning, following their activities and progress online in their learning story e-portfolios. We encourage whānau to contribute to their child's portfolio, sharing experiences from home, comments and collaborating towards shared learning goals.

Transition to School

Children are well-prepared for Primary school. They are familiar with routines, taking care of their belongings, can write and recognise their name and participate in group activities. We support transition to school through connections with Marsden Primary and local schools, and children are invited to share their learnings with their new teachers.
